Housing Solutions for the homeless and people at risk of homelessness

Christ Mission Possible is a not-for-profit, organisation.

Our primary objective is to provide and manage secure, sustainable housing for people on low to moderate incomes who might otherwise find it challenging to secure somewhere adequate to call home.

We are connected to our community and are responsive to the local needs; we offer our tenants more than a house. We are committed to building strong and interactive communities in the areas of need that we serve.

Through our loving staff, faithful volunteers and committed partners, we are able to provide crisis temporary accommodation to over **1,500** young people, single adult men and women, women with children and families each year.

We work closely with Housing NSW and other Housing Organisation's to address the big problem of homelessness and through partnerships with many local real estates we provide access into the private rental market through our Rapid Rehousing Program

There are three main areas we work to provide secure, adequate and sustainable housing they are:

Temporary Crisis Accommodation – In partnership with Housing NSW homeless persons/families access our crisis accommodation.

Transitional Accommodation – We offer people who are homeless a second chance at their own home, through our thirteen week program.

Rapid Rehousing – Is a permanent housing program utilizing the private rental market to find a home for families in crisis.
